December-February (winter season).

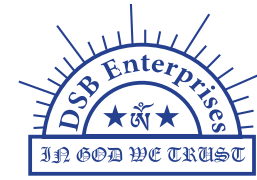
March-May (spring season).

VISA Requirement

All travellers except Indian residents require visa to come to Bhutan.

In order to process your Bhutan visa, we require a clear readable color copy of passport (page containing passport number and face picture in JPEG or PDF format) at least 20 days prior to date of entry into Bhutan. Validity of passport should extend at least 6 months from the date of exit from Bhutan.



Photography

You will want to capture everything in this captivating scenario. You can capture the landscapes, the panoramic views of the mountain ranges, the rural folk life, the flora and fauna, Bhutanese architecture and the Dzongs and Chortens; but Photographs inside Dzongs, temples, monasteries and religious institutions are restricted unless you have a special permission from the Department of Culture.
